

APPLICANTS MUST MEET MINIMUM AUSMAT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO BECOME AN AUSMAT MEMBER.

- » MIMMS (MAJOR INCIDENT MEDICAL MANAGEMENT AND SUPPORT) training, completed or enrolled
- » Currently registered to practice (if applicable)
- » Working with children and criminal clearance
- » 6 months working in the Northern Territory
- » Remaining in the Northern Territory for the next 12 months
- » Line manager as referee

DESIRABLE ATTRIBUTES OF AUSMAT CANDIDATES:

- » Work in a team environment
- » Able to work & live in austere circumstances, have flexibility and a sense of humour.
- » Languages
- » Experience working in the developing world / remote or indigenous health
- » Travel experience / life experience
- » Other skill sets/ hobbies/studies outside of health
- » Experience more than one clinical skill area (eg emergency plus midwifery)

To express your interest in becoming an AUSMAT member, create a log in and password on the secure AUSMAT site:

Register as a new user:

- » agree to the terms of use.
- » complete your personal information and be sure to select NT as your home state to be processed in the Northern Territory.
- » complete all personal information - be sure to **SAVE** your data.
- » complete your referee details - this should be your line manager in the first instance. Permission from your employer is considered essential for selection.
- » complete all remaining data - the more information provided, the easier it is for us to evaluate your candidacy.

Applicants who meet minimum eligibility will have their details reviewed by the AUSMAT volunteer committee. The committee includes NCCTRC representatives and nominated external representatives. The following information will be reviewed:

- » Referee checks
- » Experience
- » + / - Interview

Applicants will be notified in writing of their successful selection or areas to be addressed prior to selection.

On notification of your acceptance as a volunteer, you will be required to re-login and provide further details. **Your data set remains your responsibility** to ensure it remains up to date. Candidates are short listed for deployment from this data set - inaccurate or incomplete information may mean you are not considered deployment ready.

- » Successful applicants will be required to complete AUSMAT team member training, a 5 day course fully sponsored by the NCCTRC.
